#### How to use

#### 1.1 Get the code

Getting the code for the latest stable release using pip:

```
$ pip install django-freshdesk
```

You can also download the source and run:

```
$ python setup.py install
```

#### 1.2 Add the application to the project settings

Make sure that .django.contrib.auth' is installed and then add register 'freshdesk' in the 'INSTALLED\_APPS' section of your project's settings

## 1.3 Setup the settings variables

You must specify two settings variables in your settings module.

• The URL of your support page, will either a subdomain in freshdesk.com or your own domain (using a CNAME record)

```
FRESHDESK_URL = 'http://yourcompany.freshdesk.com/'
```

• The shared secret you get from Freshdesk when setting up Simple SSO

```
FRESHDESK_SECRET_KEY = '098f6bcd4621d373cade4e832627b4f6'
```

## 1.4 Register the urls

Add the application urls to your urlconf
